AKBD Exam & CKBD Multiple Choice Exam

The AKBD Exam consists of 150 multiple-choice questions that tests both kitchen and bathroom competencies. The examination itself is divided into four (4) major content categories: Planning, Construction/ Mechanical Systems, Business Management and Products/Materials. Candidates must submit their application and be pre-approved to sit for the on-site exam.

The CKBD Exam consists of 100 multiple-choice questions testing on both kitchen and bath competencies. The CKBD examination consists of four (4) major content categories: Design Solution, Specifications, Graphics/ Presentation and Mechanical/Construction. Candidates must submit their application, take the drawing portion of the exam, and be pre-approved prior to sitting for the on-site exam.
